Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We celebrate, this weekend, the Feast of Christ the King which brings us to the end of our liturgical year. Although we celebrate Jesus Christ as King of the Universe, we know that His reign is established first and foremost in the hearts and minds of individual believers who acknowledge Him to be Lord of their lives. When we have been born into a family or culture of faith, an aspect of our 'conversion' is that of moving from a simple acknowledgement of the Church's announcement that, "Jesus is Lord", to a more personal moment of acceptance that— "Jesus is MY Lord."

It is in submitting to Christ—which means that we allow Him to conquer us and take up His rightful place on the throne of our hearts—that we experience all that can be described as our salvation. This salvation can be experienced as the refreshing peace of forgiveness, or as a passionate hunger for justice; it can be experienced as a delightful courage in the heart, or an overwhelming sense of the love of God. Personal salvation can be described as the experience of being lost and found, or being empty and then satisfied... we can never fully capture in words the effects of allowing the victory of Christ to be expressed in our lives. On that note, isn't it good to hear from others and share our own experiences of the love of God, to help protect against the danger of allowing our Faith to become an abstraction which is not really grounded in personal reality.
