Finance

In case you didn't see page two of last week's newsletter, I am repeating the summary of the financial report for the last financial year. Our loss over the year was always going to be a concern because of the lockdowns etc, but it is still a matter of some considerable concern. I would ask everyone to consider using direct debit as a way of supporting the parish. I would also ask those who pay tax to consider gift-aiding their donations, whether they are by direct debit or through the envelope scheme.



Gift Aid

The Gift Aid scheme brings in an average of several thousand pounds each year and that is thanks to our Gift Aid Organiser who records all payments and submits the annual claim. Sadly, Corrine, who has been our Organiser for 18 years and who is responsible for a massive amount of money coming into our account now finds that it is time to withdraw. We owe her a tremendous thank you! This means that unless someone comes forward to replace her, we will not be receiving anything from the Gift Aid scheme in future.
