The Cathedral is the Mother Church of the Diocese and is the Church where the Bishop presides over the diocese. This year the celebrations at the Cathedral will be much reduced from their normal form, but the Cathedral choir will be providing the accompaniment for the Holy Week Services, including the Chrism Mass when the Holy Oils are blessed or consecrated for use in every parish in the diocese. Year of St. Joseph
