We have decided to discontinue the Vigil Mass and to combine the two 11.15am Masses at Holy Saviours and we shall alternate celebrating this Mass. It will be a combined Nelson parishes Mass.

The first weekend for this change will be Sunday 9th May.

There will be no Vigil Mass on the 8th May at Holy Saviour's or the weeks following.
