Tuesday 29th June Feast and Holyday of Saints Peter and Paul

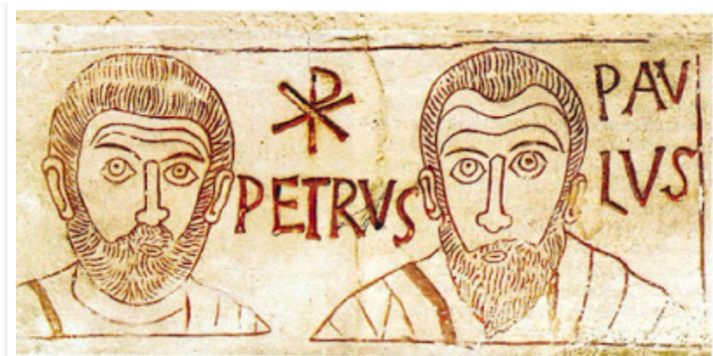
As we know, the Obligation for all Catholics to partake in Holy Mass on designated Holydays of Obligation (which includes every Sunday of the year plus a few designated principal Feast Days, such as Ss Peter and Paul) is currently suspended to allow people to exercise responsible decision making in order to keep themselves and others safe from Covid. However, the parish will celebrate the usual Holyday Masses for Feast Days, which is 10.00am at Holy Saviour's and an evening Mass at Sacred Heart. This Tuesday to give those who wish, a chance to watch the England match before coming to Mass to celebrate or mourn the result, we will put the evening Mass back to 7.30pm. I look forward to celebrating this great Feast with you.

As you know, last year, this Feast was to have been the official closing Mass of Ss Peter and Paul church, Barrowford. Unfortunately, that Mass, giving thanks for all that happened in that church, parish and hall had to be celebrated in Sacred Heart church and without a congregation, because we were in lockdown. Therefore, once again this year, our Masses on that day will give thanks for all the people and priests associated with the parish and church over its 120 year history.

As yet there is nothing to report in terms of what is happening to the building although an assessment for appropriate sale or disposal has been made to the diocese from a firm of consultants that the diocese use to advise on such things. I'll keep you informed as soon as I know anything.
