Covid Update for the Good Shepherd Parish

After most of the legal restrictions were lifted by the government earlier in July, the 'venue manager' of any place where people meet now has the responsibility for deciding the appropriate arrangements for that place. This means that we are working under the direction of the diocese and having to work out the details according to our own situation and observation as to how things are going.

We are following the direction of the diocese and the government's recommendation to all places where crowds gather to ask that everyone wears a face covering during services unless they are exempt. Distribution of Holy Communion, absence of singing, not sharing a Sign of Peace, not using Holy Water will all remain unchanged for the time being.

You are still able to book for the Vigil Mass and Sunday Masses but we will also be admitting people at the door. We will retain places for those who have booked until 5 minutes before the Mass starts. After this we will allow others in as space allows. Therefore if you have booked and do not wish to be disappointed, please ensure that you are in your place no later than five minutes before the Mass time.

The parish hall and the presbytery remain closed for the time being for any gatherings or meetings. We are waiting for further information from the diocese and the insurers about this. The only meetings allowed are in the hall for the Scout group and Brownies who operate according to the rules and restrictions of their own organisation which we have approved and under their own insurance and liability.
