Pope Francis has called a Universal Synod. This is an unusual type of synod in as far as it is not time limited. It is a call to refresh our understanding of the very nature of the Church and how we live and relate within the church.

It is based on the truth that every Baptised person has, through their Baptism, the inspiration of the Holy Spirit to guide them to the truth. The problem is that this inspiration can be difficult to discern. We have a shared responsibility to assist each other to identify the truth that the Spirit reveals.

The three stages of discernment are COMMUNION, PARTICIPATION, MISSION.

We are initially asked to share ideas on how we go about this process. More information is on page three of the website edition of this newsletter.
