# The Sacred Triduum (Easter Triduum)

The Sacred Triduum is a single Liturgical action which is celebrated in three parts. It celebrates and brings us into the Paschal Mystery of Christ, which is His saving suffering, death and resurrection. It begins with the Last Supper, then gives us the celebration of the Passion and then the Resurrecton. These three parts of the single action' will be celebrated in Colne at Sacred Heart Church on Maundy Thursday night, the celebration of the Last Supper, 7.00pm.; Good Friday, the Sacred Liturgy of the Lord's Passion, 3.00pm.; and on Holy Saturday, the Easter Vigil at 7.00pm. You will notice that there is no formal end to Thursday's Mass, no formal beginning or end to Friday's Liturgy of the Passion and no formal start to the Easter Vigil. This is to emphasise that they are all the same liturgical action taking us from the Last Supper to the Resurection of Jesus.

They will also be celebrated for St. John Southworth parish in Nelson by Father Gerard. Maundy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper 7.00pm Holy Saviour's. Liturgy of the Passion 3.00pm Christ Church and the Easter Vigil at Holy Saviour's 7.00pm.

These are the most central celebrations of our Catholic Faith so please make a special effort to make them your priority this year either in Nelson or in Colne. God bless, Fr. Peter
