Dear Parishioners and Friends,

On the 13th May, we will celebrate the feast of the Ascension which inaugurates a novena of prayer, leading up to the celebration of Pentecost.

I thought it to be most appropriate that we use this time for a major re-launching of the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the Parish.

The prayer of absolution, spoken by the priest, over the penitent goes as follows:

God, the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. AMEN

The effects of this prayer, prayed over the sincere penitent by the priest, in the name of Jesus, are beyond priceless. There are, of course, human, intellectual, psychological, and spiritual hurdles that we must negotiate in order to taste of this divine sweetness, but they are all overcome by the 'logic of faith'. I am appealing to your most mature self in taking seriously this Sacrament instituted by Christ as an essential component of his salvific work for the world. We will hear more about our Novena of Prayer and Reconciliation in the days to come.

Times of Masses in Nelson & Colne

As the weeks go by, the congregations at the weekend Masses in Nelson and Colne are gradually increasing. As yet, the Sunday Mass at Christ Church has never been fully booked, but this is not the case at Sacred Heart where maximum capacity is being reached. As we look into a somewhat unknown future, and try to find an appropriate provision of Masses, the 11.15am Mass at Holy Saviour's will now be reinstated to see how this works out.

I think it's good to be reminded that, geographically, the link between Sacred Heart church in Colne with Holy Saviour's in Nelson is something of an anomaly, especially when we take into account that Holy Saviour's church is only 0.7 miles from Christ Church.

As we move forward, we also need to keep in mind the non-pandemic-related realities, such as the over-provision of church buildings and the ever-decreasing number of priests in the Diocese. We all need to be aware of all the factors involved as, looking to the future, we seek sustainable solutions for the Catholic Church in Nelson and Colne.
