Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is still available on Friday (21st) evening from 6.00 - 7.30pm and again on Saturday morning from 9.30am - 12noon at Christ Church. The prayer of absolution spoken by the priest in this Sacrament includes the words, "...and has sent the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins." It is within the context of the Sacrament of Reconciliation that the Holy Spirit is imparted to us in the most personal of ways. In fact, it is within the celebration of this Sacrament that we can experience our own personal Pentecost!

God's purpose is to bring together all creation under the Lordship of Christ. And how does God intend to accomplish this task? Through the death and resurrection of Jesus, the Spirit explodes into the universe and, throughout all space and time, is the one source of all spiritual power. The Church, as the community of those who desire to associate themselves with Jesus, united by bonds of faith and love, is God's chosen means to channel the Life of the Spirit into the world.

The Feast of Pentecost celebrates the inauguration of the Age of the Spirit, or the Age of the Church. We are now racing towards the end of time! Our salvation has been definitively revealed in the compassionate forgiveness of Jesus; the cost of our forgiveness has been revealed in his horrendous rejection and suffering; his victory over death is our enduring hope. The gift of the Holy Spirit brings us into these dynamics of love, communicating them to our hearts as a living hope for the world.

May the Lord have mercy on our Parish and endow us with the Power to fulfil our God-given mission.
