Cafod collection and general collections.

Just to let you know what you have given, I'm delighted to tell you that so far this year you have given a very generous £1,343.76 to Cafod. That's how much has come in through the Cafod buckets at the back of church. I can assure you that Cafod have let us know that they are very much involved in relief work in many countries and are very grateful for your contribution.

Just to let you know how things are going generally, last week you gave £650.17 in the church collection. That compares with a collection of £1,116.53 on the last Sunday of May in 2019. (Church was closed in May 2020.) However, considering that the total number in church last week at the three Masses was about 142 compared to our regular Sunday attendance of about 400 two years ago, that is very generous and we are very grateful to you.

However, money continues to go out quickly and our bank balance is still going down with our payments exceding our income. We have just received the invoice from the diocese for the repairs to the roof at Sacred Heart earlier in the year. That was a bill for just over £7,000.

Normally, we would have expected to switch off the heating some time before Easter, but with the cold spell we have experienced we have not been able to do that, and heating the churches is a considerable expense.
