Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2022

Tuesday 18th—Tuesday 25th Jan

At the centre of the Christian faith stands the person of Jesus who calls us to follow him, not as individuals, but as members of one family. Although the Church is called to be a reflection of the life of the Trinity, in which three persons dwell in a perfection of loving communion, the reality with which we are faced can be something rather different!
