What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid allows UK charities to claim back the basic rate of tax (25%) already paid by you on your donations.

This means that parishes can claim 25p back from the government for every £1 that you donate, and it doesn't cost you anything!

Who can Gift Aid?

For the parish to claim Gift Aid on your donation, you must have paid UK Income or Capital Gains Tax in that financial year.

The amount of annual tax you pay must be at least the amount of Gift Aid that the parish reclaim on your total donation that tax year.

Example

If an individual donates £400 in total in one year, 25% of that amount can be reclaimed by the parish as Gift Aid, thus an extra £100 can be reclaimed (as long as the individual paid at least £100 in tax in that year).

I am a UK tax payer and I want to Gift Aid my donations. What do I do next?

Please complete a Gift Aid form and return it to the parish office.

The Gift Aid form is available on the parish website (in the Newsletter section), or paper copies are available in the church porch. You can return completed paper copies to the parish office or attach a scanned completed form to the office email address (enquiries@goodshepherdpendle.org.uk)

How can I donate?

You can have a box of envelopes with a unique number so that your regular donations can be recorded, or you can complete a standing order mandate for your bank so that donations are transferred directly to the parish account.

What else do I need to know?

Name and address details must be current and correct for Gift Aid to be claimed, so if either change, please inform the parish office.
