Donating to the parish

The new boxes of weekly envelopes will be available for collection from the back of both churches from the weekend of the 23rd/24th April. for the next four weeks at the weekend masses. As a reminder, please note that the envelopes carry an identifier number linked to a specific name, so that donations can be tracked for the claiming of Gift Aid. It's important that we have the correct address for those who have Gift Aid, so please inform the parish office if your address has changed.enquiries@goodshepherdpendle.org.uk or 01282 863135.

If you have previously been donating using the envelope system, please consider switching to an easier method, which is direct giving by standing order. You just need to complete a standing order mandate form, return it to the parish office and they will send it to your bank.

Finally, if you are a taxpayer, please consider completing a gift aid form, if you haven't already done so, as the parish can claim an additional 25% on your donations.

Both forms (standing order mandate and gift aid) are available in the church porch or can be downloaded from the parish website (newsletter section).

PS. If you have been giving to Good Shepherd Parish through the envelope system, the new envelopes have been bought and paid for and will be available at the back of Sacred Heart and Holy Saviour churches. Very soon, the Sunday collection at Holy Saviour's will be going to St. John Southworth parish as Fr. Gerard takes over full pastoral administration of the church and the rest of Nelson up to the Colne and Barrowford borders. You may then decide it is no longer appropriate to use a Good Shepherd envelope and you may ask for a St. John Southworth envelope or standing order. That decision is entirely yours. There is no pressure, but the envelopes will be available from Good Shepherd for those who wish to contribute. I'm sure Fr. Gerard will forward the Good Shepherd envelopes in Holy Saviour's collection to the Good Shepherd parish. Similarly if anyone from St. John Southworth parish comes to Mass in Colne and puts one of their envelopes in the collection, we will forward it to St. John Southworth parish. This is particularly important if you are part of the Gift Aid scheme. Only your own parish can collect your Gift Aid. Thank you for your support. Fr. Peter
