Currently we have two 'Sunday' Masses, which is perfectly adequate at the moment for the numbers who are coming. They are a Vigil Mass at 6.00pm on Saturday and a morning Mass at 9.30am on Sunday at Sacred Heart Church, Colne. I am interested to hear people's views about whether or not these are the best times for Mass.

If we are to have a Vigil Mass, is 6.00pm the best time for could it be a little earlier or later, perhaps 5.00pm or 6.30pm?

Is 9.30am the best time on Sunday? Would it be better a little later, perhaps 10.00am or 10.30am?

Would it serve the parish better if we did not have a Vigil Mass but had two Sunday morning Masses, perhaps a 'quiet' Mass at 8.00am, 8.30am or 9.00am and a later 'sung' Mass at 10.30am?

I would not envisage offering a Sunday evening Mass because when we had one at Saint Peter and Paul's, the numbers became very low toward the end.

Please have a think and a talk about it and I'll devise a way of collating your views in a couple of week's time.
