# Good Shepherd Parish Sunday Mass provision.

Currently we have two 'Sunday' Masses, which is perfectly adequate at the moment for the numbers who are coming. They are a Vigil Mass at 6.00pm on Saturday and a morning Mass at 9.30am on Sunday at Sacred Heart Church, Colne. I am interested to hear people's views about whether or not these are the best times for Mass.

If we are to have a Vigil Mass, is 6.00pm the best time for could it be a little earlier or later, perhaps 5.00pm or 6.30pm?

Is 9.30am the best time on Sunday? Would it be better a little later, perhaps 10.00am? (I have removed the 10.30am suggestion because there will be times when it will be necessary for one priest to celebrate the Mass at Sacred Heart and then the 11.15am at Holy Saviour's.)

Would it serve the parish better if we did not have a Vigil Mass but had two Sunday morning Masses, perhaps a 'quiet' Mass at 8.00am or 8.30am and a later 'sung' Mass at 10.00am?

Please have a think about it. I invite you to stay behind after Mass next weekend, 9/10th July (either the Vigil or Sunday Morning) and we can exchange views, alternatively, you can email your thoughts to enquiries@goodshepherdpendle.org.uk and head it 'Mass times.'
