Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Just looking ahead to the new school year, which will be upon us more quickly than we might think, it is time to look at what we can do for children (and their parents) in terms of providing something child-friendly at the Sunday Mass at Holy Saviour's.

We often hear of the home-school-parish partnership in bringing up children into an awareness of faith and the Church; but just as the parents depend upon the school for most of their child's educational needs, the parish depends so much on the parents to foster a sense of faith, and to develop in their children a sense of belonging to the Church.

Although the parish community has a responsibility to support parents in their duty to bring up their children in the practice of the faith, it is unrealistic to think that the parish can be a substitute for that necessary parental example and encouragement in the home.

However, I feel we need to do everything we can in order to help those parents who are making a great effort to keep themselves and their children in contact with the Eucharistic community of the parish.

We already have a children's liturgy in place at Christ Church, and I now propose that this is something that we might introduce, or reintroduce, at Holy Saviour's.

As with every other church activity the more helpers we have, then the lighter the load becomes, and it's so much easier to volunteer to help on a once-a-month basis than taking on a weekly commitment.
