**Childrens' Liturgy at the 9.30am Mass**

I think it is time now to be thinking about restoring a childrens' liturgy on occasions. Some of you have been involved with this before and know what it is about and are well able to provide it. Others may be interested in supporting or indeed leading this Liturgy.

Children's Liturgy is not a creche or 'escape' for young children. It is a presentation of what is happening in church aimed at a particular age group so that they can have a parallel experience of the first part of the Mass. In other words it is an 'age-appropriate' Welcome, Penitential Rite, Liturgy of the Word, Exposition of the Word and response to the Word in Prayer (Bidding Prayers), in a parallel liturgical setting.

I would be grateful if anyone interested would get in touch with me with a view to calling a meeting of those interested. The meeting would be to discuss 1. target age group 2. frequency 3. Resources 4. Location and Setting 5. Relating it to the Sunday (plenary) Celebration and of course 6. Safeguarding arrangements. Anyone interested, please get in touch with Fr. Peter.
