#### Two upcoming collections which we are required to take.

We did warn you that there appears to be a rather heavy run of special appeals which the diocese requires us to take over the next few weeks. Clearly we cannot expect everyone to give equally generously to each. What we can do is let you know what the special collection buckets will be for and leave it to you to decide which you wish to support and to what extent.

**CAFOD Family Fast Day** is a twice yearly collection and the next Family Fast Day is Friday 7th October. You are invited to go short of some food or drink you might ordinarily have on that day and give what you save to those who have little or nothing to live on. There are Cafod envelopes and there will be a Cafod bucket at the back of church next weekend.

**Prisoners' Sunday** is an annual day for considering not just prisoners, but also their families and particularly their children who can experience hardship and victimisation through no fault of their own. The Catholic charity PACT is our means of supporting them. The collection is on the 9th October.

#### Christmas Fair, Sunday November 27th.

There will be a short meeting in the Church Hall after Mass next Sunday (9th October) to make plans for our Fair. If you are able to help with the Fair, either before or on the day, please come down. If you would like to help but can't attend please ring Margaret on 862798.
