MASS OF HEALING AND NEW LIFE

Our Mass of Healing and New Life was, according to all human observation, a great success! The church was more than full—spilling over into the café area—which was, in itself, a sight to behold! The prayer teams included Rev Rick and three more of our Methodist friends, which added a most important ecumenical dimension to our Mass. The children's liturgy had to be re-located to

the Pendle room in order to accommodate numbers - thanks to Amanda Duckett and Linda Goddard for providing this valuable service for the children. There were many new faces in the church which allows us to begin to describe ourselves as an evangelising community!

But, although all of the above is wonderful in itself, it is only the beginning of what might be reported about the occasion. The most important aspect of our *Mass of Healing and New life* was the more hidden work of what the Lord has done in hearts, minds, and lives which were open to the healing and life-giving touch of Jesus.

In the Gospel of the day, Jesus asked the woman who was healed to stand up and make herself known. And I would ask that we begin to share with others what we have experienced through the reception of the Sacrament of the Sick, or through the ministry of prayer. We do not ask ourselves, "Have I been healed?" but we ask, "How have I been healed?" It can sometimes take some time to discern the presence of new life in our souls, but a sure sign is that we come to realise with deeper conviction that, ultimately, it's only in Jesus that we will find what we need and desire.

Later that same day... over at Holy Saviour's, in a rather less crowded church, two inspectors (Fr Gerard and Joe Winkley), one supervisor (Eva), and two workers (Ash and Martin) were spending time re-ordering the church, installing the organ from Vaughan Street in its new home. This allows the choir to come down from the balcony, and not to have to negotiate the rather perilous staircase each week.

This Sunday is the first week of our newly re-stablished children's liturgy at Holy Saviour's. The Gift Team from Holy Saviour's school will be helping us to get started so we thank them for coming to join us.

Sorry for the late newsletter—but I had to wait for the news to happen!
