The Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation captures the full meaning of Advent, in that it is the ideal preparation for the celebration of the presence of the Lord in our lives! The baby Jesus is born into the humble stable; the Light shines in the darkness; the Saviour comes to reconcile us to the Father; and words of forgiveness are spoken to the repentant sinner.

These statements of faith give us glimpses into God's plan of salvation for the world, but it's only when we make our own personal step of faith that we enter into this dimension of life that is hidden from the casual onlooker. We ourselves must step into the stable; we must recognise the darkness that engulfs our world; we must desire to enter into a close friendship with God; and we must long to know God's forgiveness for our sins.

The 'Inn without vacancies', where worldly merriment is the order of the day, still stands on the corner of every street! The real excitement is taking place elsewhere! It's away from the lights and the music that the glory of God shines forth and the sound of angels can be heard!

Why not slip down to church, and, in that seemingly rather unspectacular meeting with the priest, find the only One, Jesus himself, who can speak the most important words we can ever hear:

"I absolve you from your sins... go in peace"
