### Dear Parishioners & Friends,

On New Year's Day, the Church invites us to turn our gaze to Mary, the Mother of God, who looked to the future with absolute confidence as she announced: "Henceforth, all generations will call me blessed." As Mary looked to the future, she saw only God's continuing providence unfolding in her life.

We too can have that same hope for the future, but it begins by adopting Mary's attitude to the present moment— "I am the handmaid of the Lord, be it done unto me according to your word!"

If we can say that we want only what God wants for us—neither more nor less—then we are released from the gambler's attitude to the future in which happiness and fulfilment are tied to events which are outside of our control.
