Food Bank Update

We opened the food bank at the beginning of Advent on 1st December. We have opened every Thursday morning for the last six weeks and so far, thanks to your unstinting generosity, we have sent home food parcels with enough food for several meals for over 205 people. Thank you so much.

In addition to the Food Bank, 69 people have attended the Warm Space, enjoying a cup of tea or coffee and toast, crumpets or a toasted tea cake. Please remember -everyone welcome 9.30 – 12.30p.m. on Thursdays in the parish hall.

The collection for the food bank is on-going. There is a box at the back of church for donations. Thanks again.

Please remember that the Warm Space is separate from the Food Bank and is an invitation to anyone who wishes to come along to a warm place to socialise, have a brew, play dominoes or whatever and relax.

Digital Collection Plate


After indicating the amount you wish to give, you will be asked if you wish to 'gift aid' your donation. This will bring an extra 25%, but please ensure that you only 'gift aid' if you are paying tax.

If you do indicate that you wish to 'gift aid' you will be taken to a screen which first asks for

- 1. your first name,
- 2. vour surname.
- 3. your house number or house name
- 4. your post code
- your email address.

In future transactions you will not need to re-enter this information because your card will be recognised. After giving a 'gift aided' donation, you will receive a confirmation email later that day.

At the moment, any donation will be credited to the parish, but at some stage we wll be able to
