### Dear Parishioners & Friends,

For those who "like to get your money's worth!", the Christmas season ends this week on the 2nd of February with the celebration of the Feast of the Presentation or Candlemas this Thursday.

The Feast is celebrated forty days after Christmas as we remember the Baby Jesus being brought to the Temple to be dedicated to God's service.

Although the Feast has its roots in the Old Testament times, like all the words and events of the Old Testament, the full meaning is revealed in the New Testament when Jesus is born into our world.

Simeon, is the man on hand to be our commentator on the event, and he calls out:

"Lord, now let your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation which you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel".

Luke 2:29–32

The light of faith has now officially been ignited in this temple encounter, the match has been struck, and bursts into life; the light has been placed on the lampstand!

Although we bless candles on this day, and offer them in procession to the Lord, our real celebration lies in our gratitude that, through baptism, the light of Christ is now smouldering in our hearts awaiting to run riot in our lives if we don't allow it to be smothered by all that is not inspired by the Holy Spirit!
