## "You are the Light of the World!"

Dear Parishioners and Friends.

Now who is talking to whom, here? We are quite certain that the above words do not refer to John the Baptist because in the prologue of John's Gospel we read that, categorically, "John was not the light, but only a witness to speak for the light!" Later in John's Gospel, Jesus announces, "I am the light of the world" (John 8:12). We are happy to acknowledge that this title represents a fitting description of Jesus whose teaching and guidance gives light to our steps (Ps 119;105). However, in this weekend's Gospel these words are directed from Jesus to all those who choose to listen to him: "You are the light of the world" (Matt 5:14)! Who, me? Yes, you!

In our days of energy crises, we might have, understandably, turned our house boilers down a degree or two; but maybe it's in these times of economic gloom that we must stoke up our light of faith so that we can shine as brightly as can be.

Does it not seem that in so many ways the world is a dark place? And where is the source of new light to be found? The answer is always in Jesus, but Jesus shines his light through the hearts of his disciples, so may not our hearts be clouded and cluttered, and may the light of Christ shine out in our world!
