The St John Southworth Parish Finance Committee met for its quarterly meeting on Thursday 9th February; we have discussions in between these regular meetings as the need arises.

We are pleased to report to all parishioners that the parish finances remain strong and that the income received in 2023 exceeded the expenditure.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all parishioners for their generous regular weekly/monthly donations during the year. This is the only source of income coming into the parish which enables it to continue to operate.

There has been a great uptake in setting up standing orders during 2022 which now number 85 each month. We would encourage any parishioners who are not currently using this method to set one up. It is a much easier way of regular giving and enables the parish to plan its finances more efficiently, particularly with some major expenses coming up at Holy Saviour's this year. Please speak to Fr Gerard if you are willing to set up a standing order.

Just to clarify, we do not and have never received any financial assistance from the Diocese; in actual fact, the opposite occurs. We had to give over £7,000 to the diocese last year to cover its central administration costs! Gerard Spain, on behalf of the Finance Committee.
