# The SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

On Laetare Sunday we are called to live in the light of the Lord! Even a thin layer of guilt or shame is like a layer of dust on a mirror which takes all the brightness out of the reflected image. As the dust builds up, we become accustomed to coping with the ever more obscure image, until it is wiped away, and then... Wow! We are called to reflect the light of Christ from our lives, so let's allow him to shine from us! The children who will receive their First Forgiveness this weekend are leading the way!

As we move into the latter part of Lent, I am now looking for opportunities to offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I will be in the confessional at Holy Saviour's from 6.15 until 6.50pm before the Stations of the Cross on Mondays and before Mass on Wednesdays.

On this coming Thursday, when there is no Mass in the morning, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Confessions from 10.00am - 12.00noon.

The Feast of the Annunciation is on Saturday 25th March, and we will celebrate it with Mass at Holy Saviour's at 12.00noon preceded by Confessions from 11.15am.
