This evening, Wednesday at 7.00pm, there will be a Eucharistic Service at Holy Saviour's.

Tomorrow, Thursday, there will be a time of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 10.00am - 12.00 noon, but there will be no Confessions. Don't forget the Deanery Mass at Christ Church at 7.00pm which will now be led by Fr David Featherstone. One of the visiting priests will be available for Confession from 6.30pm

On Friday, there will definitely be Mass at 12.00 noon for the CAFOD Mass and Soup. Fr Peter has kindly put himself on standby for if I am still testing positive.

On Saturday, the 25th March, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, I'm sure I'll be testing negative so I'm intending to keep to the original plan of Mass at 12.00noon at Holy Saviour's, and this will be preceded by Confessions from 11.30am

Just to remind you that on Monday we have the *Stations of the Cross* which takes place at Holy Saviour's at 7.00pm, preceded by Confessions from 6.15pm.

May our Lenten penances—both the ones we choose for ourselves, and the ones the Lord chooses for us!—help us to deepen our surrender to God's ways. Fr Gerard.
