Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In the resurrection of Christ we see the triumph of good over evil, and of life over death. This explosion of divine light fills every nook and cranny of the universe, but the place where God desires the light to shine most brightly, is in the hearts of the disciples of Jesus. "You are the light of the world."

It was only in the light of the resurrection that the apostles and disciples came to a true realisation of who Jesus was, and they now began to understand all the words he had spoken. May the Risen Lord be our strength, our joy, and our hope as we celebrate his presence in the Church and in our lives this Easter.
