"I shall ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate" (Jn 14:16)

This coming Thursday, we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension, and on this day the Church inaugurates a novena of prayer for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

I must admit that throughout my years at school, the Holy Spirit (formerly referred to as the Holy Ghost!) hardly featured in my religious education lessons, and even less so in my actual life! The Christian faith, however, is a rather dull and unattractive proposition when it does not include an awareness of the action and activity of the Holy Spirit as a living power in our lives.

We were born to know, love, and serve God, and this knowing, loving, and serving is brought about by the action of the Holy Spirit; the melting and molding of our hearts, which is the work of the Holy Spirit, is experienced as a transformation, or conversion, of our desires.

If you are able to say that you have a living relationship with the Holy Spirit, you will not need any encouragement to enter into a novena of prayer knowing that the Holy Spirit is the Gift beyond all measure. If you are not yet sure of what it's all about, then I can only encourage you to open your hearts, minds, and imaginations to dare to believe that the ultimate promise of Jesus is available to you!

The Holy Spirit needs only the slightest flicker of a desire in our hearts for him to make an extraordinary difference to our personal lives, and consequently to our life as a church and community.

I would invite you to pray the prayer below over the days leading up to Pentecost—nine days is good, but ten days would be better, eleven days of prayer would be better again.... and so on!
