Dear Parishioners and Friends,

'Drunken revellers tumble out on to the streets of Jerusalem causing havoc and mayhem!'

So might have read the headline news in the Jerusalem Post on that day. The Holy Spirit has fallen upon that first group of disciples, and they are disorientated and euphoric as this new experience of God's presence takes them by such surprise.

The Holy Spirit is **eruptive** as he bursts forth from the heart of God, manifesting himself to those who have allowed their heart to be captured by Christ. He is **disruptive** in that he brings about a new order of reality – human goals and achievements pale into insignificance before God's plan of drawing the human race into an eternal Kingdom of love and happiness. And the Holy Spirit is **interruptive** as he comes into our personal lives with ideas, promptings, and plans that do not have their origin in our own hearts, but which spring from the life of Christ, present to us through his Spirit.

This is the day of Pentecost when the power of God is made available to the human race. Those insatiable longings for something better, for something more satisfying, for something more meaningful and enduring than all that we experience in this earthly life—wonderful though these things can be—are gathered together and taken up into our faith in Jesus.

The release of the Holy Spirit into the life of the early Christians was effected by the death and resurrection of Christ; in the same way, the release of the Spirit into our lives will be proportioned to our willingness to be drawn into the death of Christ that we may rise with him. Or, rather, that he may rise within us!

My prayer, for myself and for the parish, is that through the fog of secularism and busy-ness, which define the culture of our day, we may glimpse the truth of Christ and beg him to shine the guiding light of his Spirit into our lives.

May the Lord bless us all with a new experience of his Holy Spirit.
