### **Universal Synod and Local Synod**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In order to encourage a prayerful dimension to the Diocesan Synod, Bishop John is leading a series of Holy Hours around the Diocese to which everyone is invited. Our local Holy Hour will take place at

St Mary's, Burnley on Tuesday 25th July, 7.00--8.00pm

Please do consider attending as a sign of our support for the Diocese and as a sign of unity with all the Catholics from other parishes in the Deanery.

It might be good to remind ourselves of the two Synodal processes which are currently in progress in the Church. First of all, there is the Universal or World-wide Synod which was called by Pope Francis in 2021. The Universal Synod is a process of consultation and listening which invited submissions from every diocese in the world about what we consider to be the needs, challenges, and opportunities for the Church in our times. The Universal Synod is now in its final stages of collating and organizing all the data which has been produced. The bishops of the world will gather in Rome in October to discuss what the Synod process has brought to light; and then in 2024 they will meet again to bring the whole process to a conclusion.

Secondly, Bishop John has inaugurated a synod in the Salford Diocese. Once again this is a process of gathering thoughts and observations from as many parishioners as possible in the Diocese. Monica and Amber Perviaz have agreed to be our parish representatives, but they are establishing a small team to help them bring the listening process into our parish. So far, Linda Goddard and David Zycinski have participated in Diocesan training sessions, and Siobhan James and Antonio Perez will soon be joining them. Anne Marie Coppock is also involved in the Synod process as a deanery representative.
