The words 'holiday' and 'holy day' quite clearly stem from the same root. Similarly, the words 'recreation' and 're-creation' also have common root-meanings. Quite simply, there are times when we need to rest from the business of life—not just to give our physical bodies a break from constant activity—but to allow ourselves to make contact with the deeper levels of our being.

For the person of faith, this means to make contact with the voice of the Lord who is constantly speaking to us through the deeper moods and desires of our hearts. It is with this understanding, that we see that a holiday and a holy day are one and the same thing. When we turn away from that which routinely occupies our lives, we don't turn towards nothing, in fact we can discover something more sustaining and fulfilling than we might find in the demands of our daily lives.

The world is constantly encouraging us to be secular in our thinking, in our attitudes, and in our ways of life; we are constantly tempted to deny the spiritual aspect of our being which can be crying out to be attended to and cared for. When holidays and recreation are understood merely as times of relaxation and fun, they lose that power to truly refresh and renew us so that we can return to our responsibilities with fresh energy!

Holiday and recreation are both words that originate from a culture of faith where it is recognized that only the Creator can restore that which is worn down, and only the Lord himself can provide that true rest for the soul— "In God alone is my soul at rest" (psalm 61)

Is the holiday period enabling you to spend a little more time with the Lord, so that you may come to appreciate that the holidays can truly be the most holy of days?
