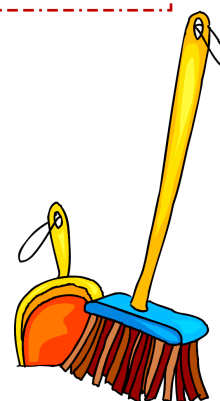
It's time to start putting dates in diaries for those who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion for the first time next year.
