Hope in the Future Celebration Event

Tuesday 3rd October 2023, 6:30pm - 9.00pm. The Edge, Riveredge, Wigan WN3 5AB

Hope in the Future was a six-year-long pastoral programme of renewal in the Diocese. Its inspiration was the Apostolic Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium written by Pope Francis in 2013. The document underlined that the essential task of the Church was that of evangelisation, which means bringing others into the experience of faith, and into the life of the Church. It was in this document that Pope Francis used the term, 'missionary disciples' to describe the role of the baptised person in the Church. Bishop John has since that time frequently referred to the idea of the 'missionary parish.' We all know that these goals and ideals are way beyond our human ability to achieve, and thus we are called, in the first place, to be a people of prayer, and open to the Holy Spirit.

At the Celebration Event on Tuesday 3rd October, we will have the opportunity to hear about what has taken place in other parishes throughout the Diocese, and to listen to young people talk about their experience of faith. The Mass of Healing and New Life is just one way in which we can respond to our calling to be 'missionary disciples' building a 'missionary parish'. Let us begin to ask the Lord whom he would like us invite to a wonderful gathering of faith and love in which "we ask the Holy Spirit to renew his wonders in our time as though for a new Pentecost!" This was the prayer of Pope John XXIII all those years ago at the beginning of the Second Vatican Council!


