# October is the Month of the Rosary!

Maybe the most well-known of all Catholic prayers, after the Mass itself, is that of the Rosary which is a prayer of meditation on the mysteries surrounding Christ's birth, death, and resurrection. In the Rosary, we call upon the intercession of Mary who was the one who shared uniquely and most intimately in the momentous events of the life of her son.

During October, we will pray one decade of the Rosary before each of the daily Masses. You might want to arrive a few minutes earlier than usual, and the prayer will begin five or six minutes before the start of Mass.

Our prayer intention will be that of the Universal Synod which moves into a new phase in October as the bishops of the world gather in Rome to reflect on the feedback that they have received, so far, from Catholic parishes and communities throughout the world.

Another opportunity to pray the Rosary will be at St John Southworth School where the GIFT Team are inviting parishioners who would like to join them, to come to the school on the Wednesdays of October at 12.00noon. It would be a great encouragement to the children in the school, for them to know that their prayer is important to the parishioners and to the life of the parish!

## MASS OF HEALING AND NEW LIFE

On Saturday 14th October at 11.00am, we will celebrate a Mass of Healing and New Life at Christ Church. The Mass will include the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of the Sick and personal prayer for whatever might be the cause of our deepest anxieties. The Mass of Healing and New Life is just one way in which we can respond to our calling to be 'missionary disciples' building a 'missionary parish'. Let us begin to ask the Lord whom he would like us to invite to a wonderful gathering of faith and love in which "we ask the Holy Spirit to renew his wonders in our time as though for a new Pentecost!" (Words spoken by Pope John XXIII in 1962 before the Second Vatican Council).
