Annual Parish Mass for our Deceased Members.

Each year we come together in November to remember in particular those members of our parish and others who have died and whose funeral services have been conducted here. This year we will celebrate this Mass on Tuesday evening, 21st November at 7.00pm. All are welcome. If you have family members who have died in the last year whom you would also like to be mentioned, even if their funeral was not here, please hand their names in to the office for inclusion. We celebrate a Memorial Mass for them in which we remember them and pray for them. At this Mass we read out their names during the Prayers of Intercession and invite people to come forward and, in their memory, light a candle which is placed on a large cross in front of the altar. This cross which is transformed from a plain cross into a cross of light is symbolic of our Hope in Resurrection.

Sunday 26th November is the Great **Feast of Christ the King** which brings us to the end of the Church's Liturgical Year. We will celebrate the Feast by singing Vespers (the universal Evening Prayer of the Church) and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Please come along at 4.00pm and experience this other beautiful expression of the Church's praise of our God on this great Feast of Jesus Christ.

There will be a short practice for singing the psalms after Mass on the Sunday morning. All welcome!
