The Offertory ought to be an action in the Mass where we can symbolically show that we are offering something of our own or ourselves to God. It is also a time where we can make a concrete contribution to the wellbeing of the Church and all of its activities.

We do not expect those people to contribute to the basket in addition to what they already give! But for everyone else, we are aware that the bucket is easily missed and we would hate anyone to feel that they had not been given the opportunity to contribute to the parish.
