Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This weekend, we welcome to our 9.30am Mass, Rev Rick Ormrod who is the Methodist minister at Christ Church and the superintendent of the local Methodist circuit. As a Catholic congregation we always enjoy Rick's enthusiastic presentation of his message; he speaks in a way that unites us as followers of Jesus, and encourages us to be open to the Spirit, and actively involved in the mission of the Church. On the following weekend, 21st January, a member of the local council of the Knights of St Columba (KSC) will be coming to say a few words, after Communion, to the congregation at the 11.15am Mass at Holy Saviour's. In this weekend's first reading we hear how the boy Samuel is instructed by the elderly priest, Eli, to listen out for God speaking to him, and when the Lord speaks, Samuel is instructed to reply, "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening!"


