Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We sometimes see clips from talent shows which show us the worst performances of those who never made it to the show, but who were rejected at their first audition! It's not really wholesome entertainment to make fun of somebody who is so much lacking in awareness of themselves and their abilities that they think they might be successful singers even though they can't sing in tune! Our attitude towards these unfortunate souls should be one of sympathy and understanding.

As Christians, we have a deeper reason to identify ourselves with the wanna-be stars when we realise that in our own lives we too might be suffering from a similar lack of awareness. We can think that we are doing pretty well - just need to work on the patience and say a few more prayers and all will be well! However, Jesus brings us up short and says to us "Repent, and believe the Good News." The word 'repent' is a strong word. It doesn't mean, "Go away and brush up your performance and better luck next time round!"

To repent means to radically change our understanding of ourselves and realise that, according to God's standards, we are failures, and our attempt at living the Christian life is hopeless. "You are indeed holy, O Lord, the fount of all holiness." To the world of holiness, we have no contribution to make!

It's only when we come to an awareness that we are in absolute dire need of God's grace that we can hear the gospel as the good news that it is. Jesus, himself, is going to give us everything that we need. He will sing in our hearts so that we can sing the tune that we can't find for ourselves!

Without God's grace, nobody is going through to the next round!
