## Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This coming Friday, 2nd Feb, brings us to the 40th day of the Christmas season, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This feast day is also known as Candlemas when the Church blesses the candles which will be used to proclaim, and to remind us, that Jesus is the Light of the World, and on this day, the Light began to shine, at long last, in the Temple.

At the heart of this celebration is the encounter of Simeon and Anna with the Christ Child in the Temple. It is in that holy encounter that Jesus' divinity is manifested by a human prophet for the first time. At His birth, the angels proclaimed His divinity to the shepherds, but in the Temple, Simeon was the first to understand and proclaim Jesus as the Saviour of the World. He also prophesied that this salvation would be accomplished by a sword of sorrow that would pierce the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Anna, a prophetess, also came forward and "gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem" (Luke 2:38). Thus, these ritual acts were also a moment in which Jesus' divine mission was made manifest to the world.
