When I was appointed parish priest to St John Southworth parish in January of 2020, the Bishop presented me with two particular focal points for my ministry, beyond the regular responsibilities of any parish priest in any parish. These two focal points were both, at the same time, challenges and opportunities.

The first focal point was to work closely with Fr Peter so that together we might reflect on what might be a realistic and manageable configuration of churches and parish areas in Nelson and Colne, and their surrounding districts. As it happened, the unforetold pandemic had its part to play in how things would work out. However, for the time being, we now have a settled solution; and I say 'for the time being' not to cause alarm but to recognise that the Church has to continue adapting its resources to its needs in our times of constant and rapid change.

The second focal point for my ministry in Nelson was to work closely with the Methodist community in what is a unique situation in the country in that we have a church building which was planned and built as a joint venture between Catholics and Methodists. I must say that I am pleased that I missed out on what must have been very intense meetings in drawing up the design and decoration of the church, and then working out, in those early days, how this relationship might work!

I'm also very pleased to say that Rev Rick, the current Methodist minister, is very accommodating and encouraging when it comes to joint initiatives. He brings a Methodist enthusiasm for the Gospel and has preached several times at Christ Church where he is always well received. Conversely, I have led Methodist services in several of the circuit churches and have always received a warm welcome.

I remind you of these things in order to put our Anniversary Celebration into a context. Our partnership is ongoing and, like every relationship, needs to be stimulated and nurtured if it is not to grow stale. Catholics and Methodists have been meeting to pray over the last few months, and so much work has been put into the planning of this occasion. All we need now is.... your presence! As a sign we take seriously the challenges and opportunities the Lord presents us with, please do come along! With love and prayers, Fr Gerard.


