With latest reports showing a growing number of people both around the world and in the UK at risk of modern slavery, Caritas Salford and the Diocese of Salford have launched a new initiative to further help stop modern slavery in all its forms in communities in Greater Manchester and Lancashire.

Our churches and schools are often the first place that people experiencing the crime of slavery turn to for support and the special Modern Slavery: Breaking the Chains training session (in partnership with the Santa Marta Group, Greater Manchester Police and the Medaille Trust) seeks to help us all gain a better understanding the risks of Modern Slavery and how to address them and support those affected.
