(Mark 6:31)

After a series of busy Saturdays here in the parish, with the Catholic/Methodist Celebration, the Anniversary Mass of Healing and New Life, the KSC Sponsored Walk, and the parish trip to Southport, I had decided that a free Saturday might be an opportunity for a personal day of reflection and retreat. Little did I know that Jesus himself had planned a time of retreat with his disciples on the very same weekend! Jesus and his disciples went off in a boat to a lonely place, whereas I went off in my car to Stonyhurst College where a Franciscan friar was leading a retreat weekend. Just as Jesus' retreat was cut short by the demands of pastoral ministry, I too would not be able to stay for the duration of the retreat because of my Sunday morning commitments!

I knew that I needed some time to write something for my newsletter, and was wondering what theme I might take up, but with the Gospel reading speaking about Jesus' retreat day with his disciples, I thought that the retreat master might provide me with some reflection points that I might share with you! So, off I went, armed with pen and paper, my ears alert to anything the Lord might give me through the humble Franciscan friar. I was not disappointed!

Fr Emmanuel, who was leading the retreat, reminded us that the word 'retreat' does not mean running away form life with all its demands. He spoke of the meaning of a retreat as being a military term signifying a temporary withdrawal from the battle in order to reflect, regroup, and return! This is an essential strategy for the soldiers who become battle-worn, and correspondingly, an essential strategy for the serious Christian who becomes sapped by the constant demand to battle against our own self-centred perspectives and recentre ourselves on Jesus.

Fr Emmanuel is based in a community in Bradford where their particular mission is to live with the poor. According to the model of Jesus and St Francis their mission is to enter into the lives of those they come to serve. On the first Saturday of each month they have a 'spiritual day' which is open to anyone who wants to join them. With my parish-priest ears alert to opportunities, I thought that maybe we might plan to visit them on a future First Saturday! All those in favour, say 'Aye'
