Ask your MP to protect life in the new Parliament

Many MPs with a strong pro-life voting record in Parliament have lost their seats.

As the new Parliament begins, we are expecting attempts from MPs to introduce <u>an extreme abortion law</u> that would make it more likely that healthy babies are aborted at home for any reason, up to birth. On the end-of-life front, last week <u>Lord Falconer introduced a Bill</u> in the House of Lords to legalise assisted suicide and the Prime Minister has pledged that he will make time for MPs to vote on the introduction of assisted suicide.


As we face these major threats, it's important to make it clear to both new and returning MPs at the start of this parliamentary cycle that they have a large number of voters in their constituency who don't want to see extreme anti-life changes to our laws.

We have launched an <u>EasyAction tool</u> on our website that makes it simple for your parishioners to contact their local MP asking them to oppose these radical changes to the law.

Since we are likely to face threats in the new Parliament on both beginning and end-of-life fronts. Ask your local MP to protect the most vulnerable.
