Please ask the Lord to bless us on this day: that Ken McCabe, our retreat guide, will be inspired by the Holy Spirit, and all of us who attend may be drawn more deeply into the life of God.

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Next week, I will not be in the parish because I am attending a week-long course for priests. The course concerns all the ways in which priests are called to minister to the people they serve but especially through the means of personal encounter and prayer. This would obviously include the Sacrament of Reconciliation which is the Church's most formal and instituted encounter between the priest and the individual person. And another sacrament of personal encounter is that of the Sacrament of Anointing, a sacrament in which we meet the Risen Christ who reaches out to help us in our weaknesses, whatever those weaknesses happen to be. However, the formal ways of ministry do not exhaust all the ways in which the Lord wants to serve his people through the ministry of the priest. The priest is encouraged to pray with those who are struggling against any and every kind of human difficulty, and to know that the Lord wants to bring divine healing and freedom into their lives.

Seventy priests have booked onto this course which tells us that the priests have a deep desire to bring the healing power of God into the lives of those they minister to. This means that, first and foremost, the priests are encouraged to become more aware of the power given to them in ordination, and more aware of the desire of Jesus to bring healing and new life into the lives of those who are seeking him. You will all be in my prayers for a blessed week,
