The older part of the roof at Holy Saviour's is more than one hundred and twenty five years old, and, not surprisingly, after more than a century of exposure to Nelson weather, it is in need of some repair work. When it is raining, and the wind is blowing in a particular direction, a large puddle appears at the front of the church just in front of the statue of Our Lady. More importantly, at least two slates have fallen from the roof and have come crashing

down on to the public pavement where they could possibly kill an unfortunate passerby.

Because all the nails which fix the tiles to the roof are of the same age, none of them are really trustworthy. The idea of spending eighty to one hundred thousand pounds on a new roof would seem to be out of the question for a building which has an uncertain future. The more simple option has been to secure about sixty loose tiles with copper straps. As a precaution against further falling tiles, a mesh has been fixed inside the troughing (gutter) to prevent any slipping tiles from reaching the pavement below.

Any job which involves scaffolding immediately takes the bill into the thousands of pounds and is a timely reminder to us that having responsibility for a building is an expensive business. Although in my five years as parish priest I have never mentioned money, I think it my duty to politely remind you that standing orders are by far the most effective and convenient ways of giving. Furthermore, may I remind you of what you already know, that standing order donations need to be periodically reviewed as inflation eats away at their value as the years go by. Our connection to the Offertory at Mass is one of sacrificial giving which not only supports the church but expresses our commitment to the sacrificial love that the Lord has for us.

Just to say a big thank you to Ewa Zycinska for refurbishing the statue of the Sacred Heart which stands above Holy Saviour's doorway. The statue was in rather a sorry state standing in a very clouded perspex case which was half full of water, but now looks well-cared for under the new l.e.d. light fitting!

May the Risen Lord be our joy as we continue to celebrate the Easter Season! Fr Gerard
