This Sunday is the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity.

Since last December we have been reminding ourselves of our Faith and our relationship with God. We recalled the Old Testament prophecies of the coming of the Messiah. We celebrated his birth, at Christmas. We rejoiced in his teaching and then we remembered his death and Resurrection in Holy Week and Easter. We have lived his promise of the coming of the Holy Spirit and celebrated it last Sunday, Pentecost. On Trinity Sunday we celebrate the whole of our story with God: Father and Creator; Son and Saviour; Holy Spirit and Life Giver.
