#### This week is an extraordinary week of feast days for us.

Sunday is the **Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ**, formerly known as Corpus Christi (Body of Christ). There used to be a separate feast of The Precious Blood, but both feasts have been combined into the feast of The Body and Blood of Christ.

The 22nd of June would have been the feast of **Saints John Fisher and Thomas More**, the patrons of our High School, but since this year that is displaced by The Body and Blood of Christ, it is being celebrated in the school on Friday 20th June. Friday is the third Friday of the month, and on each third Friday there is a voluntary Mass at 8.00am for both pupils and staff. #### Advanced Notice of a Sponsored Walk for Caritas.

Latest government figures show that four children in every ten in the area covered by the Salford Diocese are living in poverty.
