The units travel to remote endemic areas providing reliable health information and advice to address the fear and misinformation which still serves as a barrier to treatment for so many people. Relics of St Carlo Acutis to St. Mary's Church, Burnley. January 2026

This month, the relics of St Carlo Acutis will be hosted at two of our churches over five days, during which time the Diocese will welcome schools, parishioners and people from all over for veneration.

Carlo is the first millennial saint, and is celebrated for his profound faith and his use of the internet to log Eucharistic miracles from around the world. He was passionate about spreading the teachings of the Catholic Church up until his death from leukaemia at the age of 15.
